ACCEPTANCE OF THE FEES POLICY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Enrolment indicates acceptance of the fees policy on the Application Form and indicates that this policy has been read and all terms and conditions accepted.

ADMISSION FEES

All fees are for each individual child

Registration Fee Once the child's application is accepted, a non-refundable Registration Fee of OMR **300** should be paid to confirm acceptance of the place. After a place has been offered, families have 5 business days in which to reserve the student's place by making payment for the registration fee. If the registration fee is not received during that time, the place will not be held.

Assessment Fee OMR 30 for all grades

After School Activities (ASA): For ASAs offered by the school that do not require the purchase of materials, the fee will be OMR 30 per activity. If materials are required (e.g., science or cooking activities), an additional fee will apply

Checkpoints Fee: OMR 80 per student, applicable for Grade 6 and Grade 8, covering key stage assessments

All Annual and Bi-Annual payments are to be made at the time of registration / re-enrollment.

The tuition fees are invoiced as three equal installments, payable before the beginning of each academic term. A uniform sibling discount of 15% is applicable for students with siblings enrolled at the school. Where a student is eligible for multiple discounts (e.g., corporate discount), only the highest applicable discount shall apply. Discounts are not cumulative; therefore, if a student is eligible for a higher corporate discount, the sibling discount of 15% will not be applied.

In the 2026 - 2027 school year, NWIS will offer enrollment from KG1 to Grade 12.

A discount is available for full upfront payment of the annual tuition fees before the start of the academic year (Term 1). A 5% discount will be applied for payments made in cash or bank transfer, while a 3% discount will be applied for payments made via credit card.

All IT devices must be used appropriately by the students. Damages incurred through inappropriate / careless use are the financial responsibility of the family. We operate a Bring Your Own Device Policy from Grade 4 upwards. Please refer to the [BYOD Policy](#) to ensure your child is equipped with the correct device before you make any purchase.

- Please be aware that non-payment of the indicated fees with respect to the deadline will incur an OMR 20 surcharge per month.

RE-ENROLLMENT FEE

The re-enrollment period for students who will join us in the coming school year is announced by the school in February. A non-refundable re-enrollment fee of OMR 300 for each student is due latest by 15 February to secure a seat for your child in the next academic year. This is deducted from the Term 1 Tuition Fee of the following academic year. In the case of non-payment within the published time frame, the student's place is no longer reserved.

Post-dated Cheques

- Postdated cheques for termly payments are to be submitted on the registration day.
- Postdated Cheques will be deposited to the Banks on the due date.
- Please note that any returned cheque will incur a fine of 150 OMR on parent.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All Tuition Fees are billed in advance. They should be settled as per the fee schedule published by the school and must be paid before the due date.
- Scholarships and any discounts can be cancelled if the school fees are not paid on time, in addition to an applicable late fee.
- Scholarships and discounts can be revoked for non-attendance, poor academic performance and bad behavior and discipline.
- If a family would like to communicate the withdrawal of a student from NWIS, this must be done in writing to info@mynewis.com or in-person at the school front desk at least two weeks before the end of term, otherwise the next term fees are applicable.
- School fees are non-refundable. Reports and transfer certificates will not be released until all outstanding fees have been settled.
- School field trips are not included in the tuition fees.
- NWIS's fees are reviewed annually and are subject to increase. The school will endeavor to give one term's notice of any changes to the fees.
- Failure to pay fees according to the Payment Schedule would result in the temporary or permanent loss of the place in the school. If payment is not settled within the 'Due Date of Payment,' a formal warning will be issued one week after the due date. If the payment is not settled within the same term, the report will not be issued. Failure to pay before starting next term will result in the student not being allowed to attend school trips
- If a student leaves the school temporarily (subject to the school Principal's approval), fees covering the withdrawal period are still applicable.
- NWIS reserves the right to review / amend / withdraw any discounts being offered at their own discretion.
- NWIS reserves the right to discontinue enrollment for any student with prior notice to families.
- Parental liability:
 - The signing of the Acknowledgement Form by the father or mother means that the father or mother is eligible to sign and are committed to all the terms and conditions in this document.
 - The official communication tools used between parents and the school are the email address provided to us.

Withdrawal:

- Admission fees are not refundable.
- Written notice of permanent withdrawal must be provided at least one term in advance. If the required notice period is not observed, the following withdrawal fees as outlined below will be applicable:
 - Students who withdraw from the first school day up to October 31st shall pay 1/3 of the total annual tuition fees, plus the admission fees.
 - Students who withdraw from November 1st to December 31st shall pay 1/2 of the total annual tuition fees, plus the admission fees.
 - Students who withdraw from January 1st to February 28th shall pay 2/3 of the total annual tuition fees, plus the admission fees.
 - Students who withdraw after March 1st shall pay the full annual tuition fees.
- In the case of temporary withdrawal, fees covering the period of withdrawal shall remain payable.
